THE MUSEUM

Located in the heart of Brussels, the ART ET MARGES MU-SEUM is dedicated to outsider art (Art brut), self-taught art created on the margins of the established art circuit. Here you come face to face with powerful works that make you ponder the **boundaries of art and its definition**.

The collection was begun in the mid-1980s, with works by self-taught artists and persons with mental disabilities or psychiatric inpatients participating in art studios. Today it includes more than 4,000 international works, all of which were created on the margins of the art world.

Temporary exhibitions create a dynamic **dialogue** between the works of artists from both sides of the margin.

THE VISIT (AND THE WORKSHOP)

The visit makes the museum a place where people can open their eyes to differences and non-conformism.

The visit is always interactive and based on discussion, play and questions. It begins by immersing us in the work and the impression it makes on us, before moving on to the artist and the context in which it was created.

New didactic materials are designed for each exhibition to capture the interest of the youngest visitors.

The visit makes you aware of your **own artistic potential** and invites you to express your own personality as an echo of the spontaneity of the artworks on display. Therefore, the museum offers groups the chance to extend their visit with a **creative workshop** inspired by the techniques and/ or themes observed during the tour.
